Parking, Transportation & Restaurant Information

Unfortunately, the conference venue and the hotel are about 2 miles apart. Below we list complimentary or low-cost transportation options, and it is a nice walk through campus if you'd like the fresh air. **You may find it most convenient to use Uber or Lyft, call a taxi, or even to rent a car.** Rentable electric bicycles are also an option through <https://madison.bicycle.com> with a drop-off/pick-up near the conference venue, and another about 0.5 miles from the hotel.

Shuttle from the Hotel

The InnTowner's complimentary shuttle service operates within a two mile radius of the hotel between the hours of 7:00am and 11:00pm. The complimentary shuttle is for all guests. It is a first-come, first-serve basis, based on availability and holds 10 people. We recommend coming to the front desk 15 minutes prior to the time you need to leave in case the shuttle is busy. Pick-ups are not scheduled ahead of time; guests can request shuttle pick-up by calling the hotel's phone number on their key packet.
