## Transportation & Restaurant Information

The conference is being held at two different venues, the hotel on Day 1 and the Department of Environmental Quality on Day 2, 17 miles away. Below we list transportation options to help you with the trip across town. On the second day there is a complimentary shuttle from the hotel to the conference venue, but attendees may also choose to use Uber or Lyft, call a taxi, or even rent a car depending on their other travel plans.

### Transportation to the Conference

We will have a one-way shuttle from the Hyatt Place Salt Lake City/Cottonwood hotel to the Department of Environmental Quality venue on October 20th, leaving at 8:00 am.

Free parking is available at the Hyatt Place Salt Lake City/Cottonwood and the Utah Department of Environmental Quality at the Multi Agency State Office
