Transportation & Restaurant Information

The conference is being held at Massachusetts Institute of Technology in Buildings 54/55 (access via 21 Ames St, Cambridge, MA 02139). The Boston Marriott Cambridge (50 Broadway Cambridge, MA 02142) is an 8 minute walk to the conference center. Below we list transportation options and dining options in the area.

From the airport to MIT/ Hotel Area

- **Subway:** From any terminal at Logan Airport, take the Silver Line bus to South Station. At South Station, change to the Red Line subway to Kendall/MIT (inbound toward Alewife). The ride should take about 30 minutes and costs \$2.40.
- **Taxi or rideshare:** Taxi or rideshare from the airport can range from \$20-\$40. The drive will take 15 - 30 minutes, depending on if it is rush hour.

- 55 Hayward Street (\$16/hr)
- MIT - Visitor Lot: 139 Massachusetts Ave (Open 7:30-4:00, \$34 flat rate)

Getting around the area

- **Shuttle:** The [EZ Ride shuttle](#) runs to and from Boston's North Station, with stops at Kendall Square and around MIT's campus, fare is \$2 cash per trip
- **Bluebikes** is the Boston area's public bike share program. There are several [stations around campus](#). Visitors may purchase an [Adventure Pass](#), which is valid for 24 hours.
